Monthly Report

Ms. Feuerherm said the review of the County's Early Intervention program has been completed with no clinical indicators. There are some very small policy documents requiring a modification in wording to be revised. The written report will be received in several weeks and Ms. Feuerherm will provide the response as required to show the amendments have been made.

Veteran's Services Agency

Mr. Bullock said the veterans will be receiving a 2.2% pay increase effective December 1st. He also reported on legislation signed in June that will let the Veterans Affairs Secretary to fire individuals not doing their work as well as obtaining back pay from supervisors in this category.

Mr. Denkenberger spoke of how our Veterans Services office assists veterans in Tompkins County as they do not have a local office and he believes Tompkins County should recognize the shared services we do for them rather than intimate they are covering expenses for us.

Monthly Report

Mr. Ferri reported having heard from the New York State Department of Labor on how to move forward with the Workforce Development Plan. This will require working regionally with other counties to develop a regional plan, which has been the direction the State has taken. The members need to agree on a plan but there has not been direction provided on how to proceed. The plan needs to be submitted by September 23, 2017.

There has been a decrease in funding of approximately twenty percent from what is known of the Health and Human Service budget that will come out in October. The New York State staff are still anticipating this will be the case. In the event there is a twenty percent cut it will require one of the centers to close, which would require a determination of whether it should be a director position or other staff to be cut.

Grants received are primarily for apprentice programs and will take funding from other areas such as disabled workers and put it into other areas, however, the requirements that follow funding for education are making it restrictive.

Ms. Wheaton said the Summer Youth Program is winding down. This program provided the opportunity to work with professionals and two of the youth have been hired and will be continuing employment. She invited members of the Committee to join them at the City Cemetery when youth assist with cleaning stones followed by a picnic in Saugett Park. With regard to other training, there is \$30,000 being used by 8-9 individuals enrolled in BOCES programs and one is now in the LPN program. The Title V funding is at the same level, which would allow twenty hours per week employment.

Mental Health

Monthly Report

Mr. Thayer shared information on the Sequential Intercept Mapping workshop and that there will be additional meetings at the end of the month to work on crisis services and a crisis management team. He is working on obtaining funding to enable expansion to adult services. He will be working with Syracuse and the District Attorney on programming to deal with addiction.

After the noted items are complete the next step would be with regard to re-entry. he is hoping to look at educational services that could be provided to inmates, although the present jail does not have adequate space to do so.
