## JANUARY 2018 SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT REPORT

### Landfill

#### Administration

Hauler responses to Flow Control participation;  
Contract administration for Recycling Center Operations;  
RFP for supplying processed C&D to the landfill for ADC; and  
Renewal of landfill permits.

#### Operations

**Leachate Hauling** – Continued transport of leachate to the City’s WWTP, current reading at 8.6' total tank.

**Site Maintenance** – Snow removal, continued placement of bagged trash into second half of Cell 2A, stockpile shale for winter use.

**Equipment** – Repairs to Moxy haul truck (Unit 209) and excavator (Unit 213); routine service of equipment and vehicles.

### Recycling

- E-waste Recycling for November 2017 was approximately 15.14 tons at a cost to the County of \$4,661.42. The NYSDEC grant program to reimburse 50% of e-waste recycling has been extended from April 1<sup>st</sup> through the end of 2017. Applications are due this month. Total reimbursement for through the end of 2017 to be requested from NYSDEC is estimated to be \$25,000.
- Single-stream recycling for January through October 2017 received approximately 2,753 tons of materials at a cost of \$178,534.21. This total reflects the value of the commodities of \$23,132.86 paid to the County.
- Environmental Improvement Committee met on December 15<sup>th</sup> to focus on the question of future Recycling Center operations. The committee has tentatively scheduled its next meeting for the week of January 15, 2018.
